SPECIAL DOOR OFFERING THIS SUNDAY

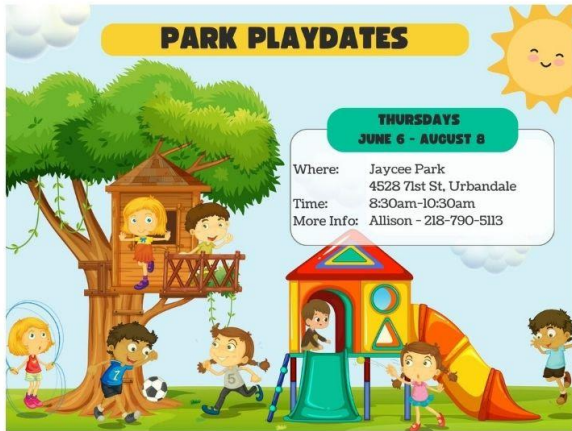
