STO HEART OF IOWA FUNDS

The Heart of Iowa School Tuition Organization (STO) provides tuition grants to eligible students attending accredited Christian schools in Iowa. These grants are funded through voluntary contributions and are awarded based on financial need.

As a participating school, Mount Olive has applications available for families who would like to be considered for tuition assistance for the upcoming 2026-2027 school year.

In addition to the completed application, families must submit a copy of their 2025 Iowa State Tax return, signed by all parties listed on the return. The tax return must list the student(s) as a dependent. If there are special circumstances—such as a divorce decree or separation agreement—where the student is not listed as a dependent, please also include a copy of the applicable documentation.

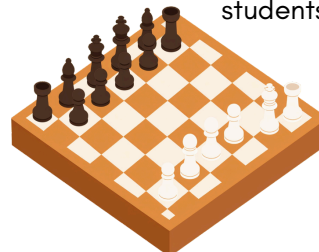
CHESS CLUB
